FESTIVITIES

Friday, 3th July. Durint the whole weekend, both cities, Baeza and Úbeda, celebrate the anniversary of the World Heritage Declaration of the Renaissance Monumental Ensembles of Úbeda and Baeza 2003. Specially in Úbeda, it is the Feast of the Reinssance.

MUSIC and SOUND ART

"Folk from the World". It is an International Festival of Music, Dance and Popular songs, celebrate in July in Baeza. There are concerts and more in different places in the city.

PERFORMING ARTS

"UNIA Escena Baeza". It is the International Festival of Threatre, celebrate during the two first weeks of July in Baeza. It is organised by the UNIA and covered a wide variety of events.

SURROUNDINGS

Arround and near the city of Baeza, there are many other places that worth visiting. Here you have some suggestions.

ÚBEDA

The city of Úbeda constitutes the Renaissance Monumental Ensembles with Baeza, and also preserves and important heritage of different cultures:

*Water Synagogue (Mon-Sun: 10:30h-14h, 17:30h-20:30h, 4€/entry ticket). *Holy Chapel of the Savior (Mon-Sun: 9:30h-14h, 16:30-19:30h, 5€/entry ticket). *Vázquez de Molina Palace (seat of the Town Hall, Mon-Fri: 8h-15h, 17h-21h, Sat: 9h-14h, free entry). *Deán Fernando Ortega's Palace (seat of a hotel), and many others. How to go: bus Baeza-Úbeda (15min, 1,18€/ticket).

OLIVE CULTURE MUSEUM

Olive trees and olive oil are main in the culture of the province. In this Museum you could learn about the olive growing and processing of olive oil (Mon-Sun: 10:30h-13:30h, 17:30h-20h, 4,50€/entry ticket, 60€/guided tour that required reserved). It is located 8km from Baeza. How to go: taxi Baeza-Museum (15min by car, 15€/taxi ride).

CÁSTULO

Cástulo is an archeological site that constitutes an important example of the ancient Iberian and Roman cultures (Tue-Sun: 9h-15h, free entry). It is located near the city of Linares. How to go: bus Baeza-Linares (2 buses/day: 9:15, 15:15h, 25min.); taxi Linares-Cástulo (15min., 15€/taxi ride).

JAÉN

Jaén is the capital city of the province. It constitutes a transit point between the North and the South of the country, and different cultures have left their traces: ◆Cathedral (Mon-Sun: 10h-14h, 16h-19h, 5€/entry ticket). ◆Arab Baths Cultural Center (Tue-Sat: 9h-22h Sun: 9h-15h, free entry). J*aén Museum (Tue-Sat: 9h-15:30h, Dom: 10h-17h, free entry for European/1,5€ rest). ◆Iberian Museum (Tue-Sat: 9h-20h, Sun: 9h-15h, free entry). ◆Sta Catalina Castle (Mon-Sun: 10h-14h, 17h-21h, Sun: 10h-15h, 3,5 €/ticket entry), and many others. How to go: bus Baeza-Jaén (1h, 5€).
